Stroke Competition - Gross and Nett

A, B and C Grades

West Aviat Stableford Cup - Sunday November 10th

Members need to have played 10 games in West Aviat competitions since last years Championships.

Grading will be decided on Daily Handicap as at close of entries (5pm, Sunday, 3rd November 2024).

This is the most important competition for our golfing year and the participation of as many members as possible is encouraged.

ENTRIES CLOSE: **6pm Sunday 3rd November 2024.** (To be eligible for the Championships an entry fee of \$30 (\$25 for Championships & \$5 for West Aviat Stableford Cup) must be paid in cash to either Leonie Cole or Wayne Eberhard by Sunday, 3rd November 2024. The entry fee for members only playing in the West Aviat Stableford Cup on Sunday, 10th November is \$5.)

DRAW - The draw will be RANDOM and emailed to all participating members before both days of competition. Please note that the draw may change up to and even on the day of competition due to any unforeseen circumstances. Any queries/complaints during the Championships, including the draw, will be handled by the Club Captain, Roger Simm.

Novelty Prizes on both Sundays will include Nearest The Pins, Longest and Straightest Drives, Best Second Shot, Longest Putts for each grade on selected holes.

West Aviat Golf Club Annual Championships 2024

The competition is open to all members of the West Aviat Golf Club. There is a 10 game qualification for the 2024 championships.

The Championships will run over two consecutive Sundays in November commencing on the 10th of November and completing on the 17th of November.

The Championship will be a 36 hole competition, however if weather conditions do not permit play on any of the designated days the number of holes of the competition will be reduced accordingly.

The West Aviat Golf Club encourages all members to participate in the championship as this is the most important competition of our club.

Listed below are the suggested grades, this may alter depending on the number of entrants.

Grades:

The championship grades to be based on participants Daily handicap at the close of entries (6.00pm the Sunday prior to the start of the championships):

A Grade: 15 and below B Grade: 15 to 23 C Grade: 24 and above

Note:

- 1. The participant's handicap for the entire championship will be that at the close of day on Sunday, 3rd November.
- 2. Grade handicap range will be finalised prior to the posting of the Championship draw.

Gross Competition:

In January 2020 the new handicapping system was introduced which takes the courses's Slope Rating, Scratch Rating and Par Rating into account when calculating individual Daily Handicap. The new software programme automatically calculates gender mixed competitions and ranks order of merit accordingly. This applies to nett competition as well.

Gross Competition - Play-Off Holes

If any grade in the gross competition has multiple winners at the completion of the championships (Sunday, 17th November) then there will be a play-off. The designated holes will be Lakes No. 11 followed by Classic No. 8, if needed. If the competition is still tied after completion of these holes then the process will be repeated until there is a winner.

Nett Competition:

The individual grade 'Nett" champions will be determined on the lowest combined "Nett" score, based on entry handicap, over the duration of the championships.
